## Today's Prayer Reflection

### "Do You Love Me?"

Jesus appears to seven of his disciples, among them Peter who proclaims his unflinching love for the Lord after each time Jesus questions him: "Do you love me more than these?" Jesus commissions him to feed the sheep only after He asks Peter three times to make a profession of love. He appoints him as the shepherd of the Lord's entire flock.

Jesus' question is also a pointed reminder of Peter's pledge to lay down his life for Jesus, even if the other Apostles might weaken. Jesus also explains to Peter what his love and leadership will require of him, thereby foretelling Peter's crucifixion. Later, in the face of persecution, Peter and the apostles proclaim the name of Jesus, the Lamb who was slain and who rescues us from death.
