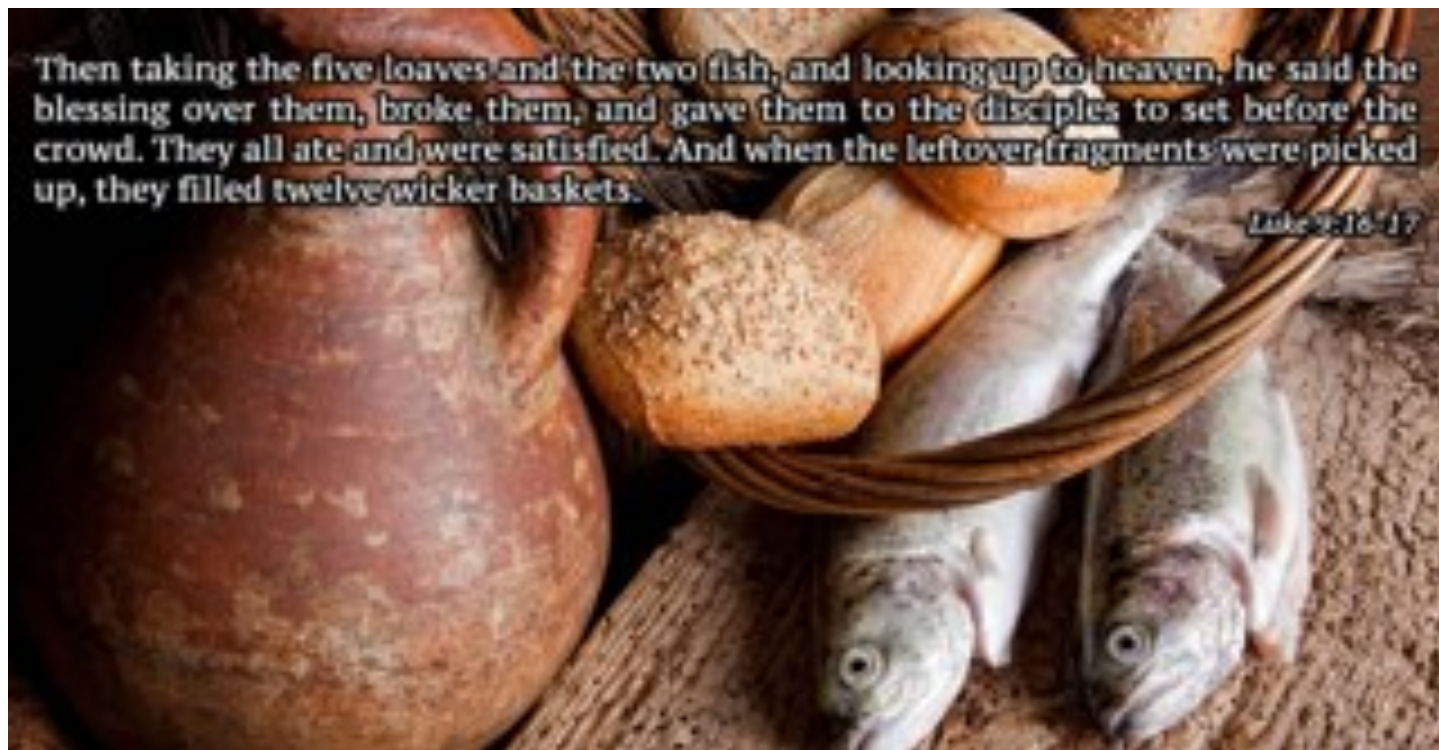

### "Corpus Christi"

Melchizedek, priest of God Most High, offers bread and wine as a blessing upon Abram in his victory over his foes. This offering foreshadows the day when we will give thanks to God and bless Him in thanksgiving for delivering us from our enemies, sin and death.

Jesus fulfils this offering, giving us his own body and blood under the forms of bread and wine. Thus is our hunger satisfied in abundance, as we make our way to the altar to receive the Eucharist. Each time we do this we proclaim His victory over death, until He comes again to make His victory our own.

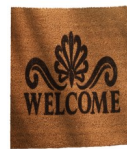
