Today's Prayer Reflection

"Restored to Life"

Elijah heals the son of the widow Zarephath. She praises the Lord that her son had been healed. Moved by compassion and without a request, Jesus raises from the dead the son of a widow of Nain. All are amazed and glorify God. These healings are visible signs of the awakening and liberating of men from the spiritual death caused by sin.

When we are dead in sin, it is the outstretched hand and the words of Jesus, spoken through the priest, that raise us from spiritual death and restore us to full life in his Church so that we might proclaim him to the Gentiles.
