Today's Prayer Reflection

"Many Sins, Great Love"

The fallen King David acknowledges his sin and experiences the Lord's forgiveness. The sinful woman who weeps at his feet is forgiven by Jesus because of her great love. Like David and the woman in today's Gospel, we fall into sin, maybe not as grave as David's or as many as that woman's, but we all often squander the great gift of salvation we've been given.

Often we fail to live up to the great calling of being sons and daughters of God. The good news in today's readings is that we too can return to God in the sacrament of confession. Our faith will save us but, we need to come to Him in true sorrow and repentance. Let us remember God loves us and He gave up His son for us. In gratitude for this great debt Jesus paid for us, let us promise to live by faith and for God alone, and devote our lives to serving Him with great love.
