## Today's Prayer Reflection

*"What We Must Do"*

### Looking at the Mass

*Sign of Peace* - This is when there is a pause in the Mass and the priest (celebrant) invites the faithful to greet each other, typically with a hand shake, signifying their union and their love of Jesus. *Blessing Yourself with Holy Water* (from the *stoup*, the holy water container) as you enter and leave the church is done as a reminder of our baptism.

Do you need to take a moment of quiet, a moment to slow down and remember what really matters? You are invited to spend it with the Lord, your Savior, at Eucharistic Adoration, with the Blessed Sacrament exposed in the chapel, every Friday from 9 am - 9 pm. Come!
