## *Open Registration Starts August 13th*

Registration for St. Peter's Parish Religious Education Program will begin on August 13th, 2016. If your children attended PREP classes last year we will have pre-printed registration forms available that include much of your registration information, which will save time during the registration process. The cost for our Parish Religious Education Program remains unchanged at \$35 for one child, \$70 for two children, and a maximum of \$100 per family.

If your child is due to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion this year, or the Sacrament of Confirmation next year, there is an additional fee of \$50 per child to cover the cost of books and materials. ## Reviewing The Seven Sacraments

The Sacraments of Healing are *Reconciliation* (or penance, confession) and *Anointing of the Sick*. Sins committed after baptism are confessed to the priest after an examination of conscience and they are forgiven by the priest in the name of Christ. Father says: "I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."



Those who are ill are anointed to impart spiritual strength and physical healing during the *Anointing of the Sick*. They are anointed with one of 3 different oils which were blessed by the Archbishop at the annual Chrism Mass. The priest recites: "Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord, who frees you from sin save you and raise you up." The other 2 oils are used in baptism and confirmation.
