PREP Registration Is Underway

Next weekend is the final weekend to register your child/children for St. Peter's Parish Religious Education Program. **Classes begin on Sunday, September 11th.** All students and parents are invited to an "Open House" next weekend, Sunday, August 28th at 9:30 am to meet the teachers.

If your children attended PREP classes last year we have pre-printed registration forms available that include much of your registration information. This will save you time during the registration process. The cost for our Parish Religious Education Program remains unchanged at \$35 for one child, \$70 for two children, and a maximum of \$100 per family.

If your child is due to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion this year, or the Sacrament of Confirmation next year, there is an additional fee of \$50 per child to cover the cost of books and materials. 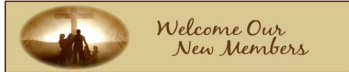
Our nursery is open to all children up to 4 years old during the 11:00 am Mass. We are located in Building 1.
