Final weekend to register your child/children for St. Peter's Parish Religious Education Program. **Classes begin on Sunday, September 11th.** Catechists will be available in their classrooms after the 8:00 am Mass this weekend to meet and greet the parents, and to welcome the children attending PREP classes this new school year.

Our nursery is open to all children up to 4 years old during the 11:00 am Mass. We are located in Building 1.

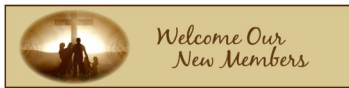


Today's Prayer Reflection
