VIRTUS Training

Abuse statistics are startling. But, abuse doesn't have to happen! When a child or vulnerable individual is abused, everyone suffers.

As employees, volunteers and parents, we are the primary protectors of our children. Their safety is up to us. As a Church, we are committed to helping you fulfill this tremendous responsibility. St. Peter's invites you to attend VIRTUS Protecting God's Children (PGC) which teaches employees, volunteers, and parents how to prevent child sexual abuse. Classes are open to everyone except children under 18 years of age. A light meal is provided.

All employees and those volunteers who have unsupervised, ongoing access to minors or vulnerable adults are **REQUIRED** to attend this training every five years. If you are a new employee or volunteer, you **MUST** register for this training session. You will learn very specific actions you can take to protect our children. Class is **Tuesday, Oct. 11th from 6:00 - 9:00 pm** here at St. Peter's. By Archdiocesan requirements, no one is admitted to the VIRTUS PGC session late.
