

Today's Prayer Reflection "No Favorites"

In today's Gospel Jesus draws a blunt picture! The Pharisee's prayer praised himself instead of God. However, the tax collector was too ashamed to raise his eyes to God but prayed with a humble and contrite heart.

Humility is the recognition that no matter what our accomplishments, we still stand in need of the Lord. God hears the cry of the poor and of the oppressed, especially those who acknowledge their dependence upon him. Having heard Paul's cries for help, the Lord crowned him with eternal salvation. We are warned not to take pride in our piety, not to slip into self-righteousness, or to think that we are better than others.
