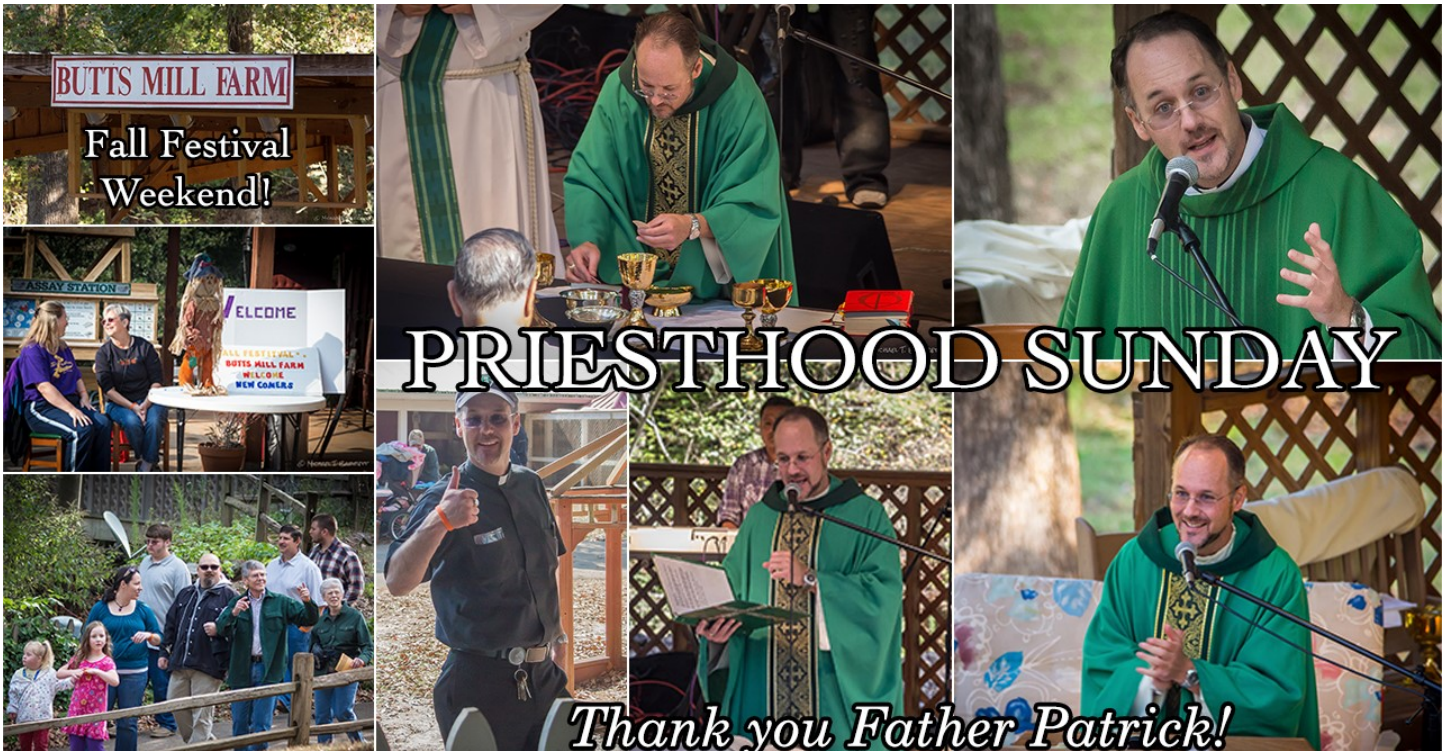

Today's Prayer Reflection

"Lover of Souls"

The Lord is full of mercy and compassion, slow to anger and of great kindness. He has come to search out and save what was lost. He gives us an opportunity to repent our sins so we will not perish in our sinfulness.

In today's Gospel we have the portrait of the chief tax collector Zacchaeus, who by profession was a "sinner" and precluded from Israel's religious life. He's gotten ahead in life by fraud, deceit and greed. Yet, he is the one who seeks out Jesus and humbles himself before him. He repents his sins, vows restitution to those he cheated, and promises to give half his money to the poor. He is exalted by his humility and justified by his faith. Again this week Jesus uses a tax collector to show us the faith and humility we need to obtain salvation. Let us seek Jesus daily with repentant hearts!
