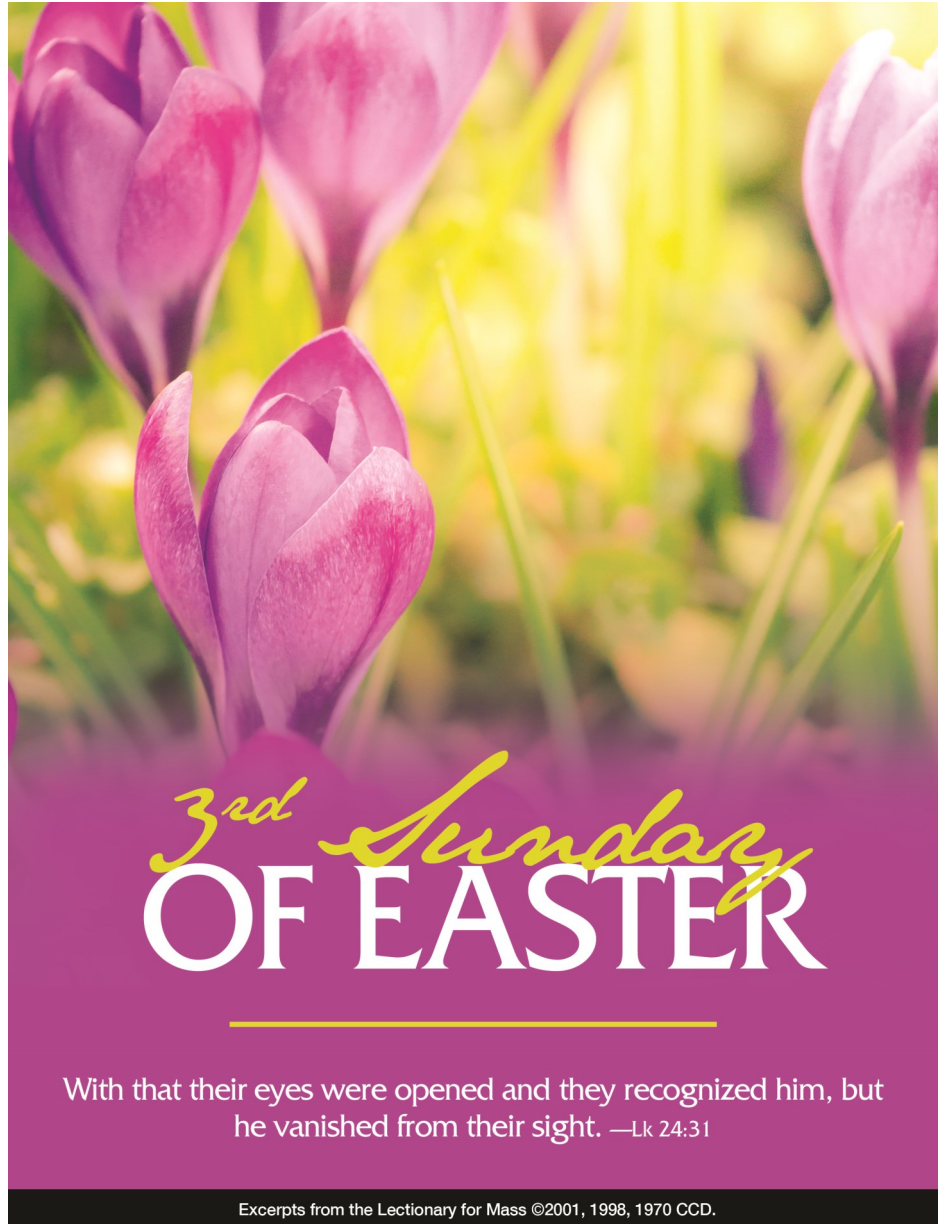

Our nursery is open to all children up to 4 years old during the 11:00 am Mass. We are located in Building 1.

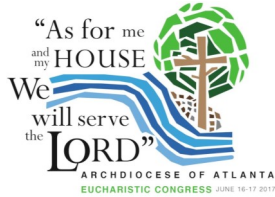
