

The Society began in the United States in 1845 in St. Louis, Missouri. By 1903, the first Conference in Georgia was formed by parishioners at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Atlanta. The Atlanta Council, now known as the Georgia Council, was instituted in 1914 to serve as a resource and support center for the growing number of Conferences. Thank Don and July Heine for their Leadership. There are now 73 Conferences in the Georgia Council. Last year, SVdP Georgia served more than 126,000 people with almost \$15 million in tangible and in-kind resources.
