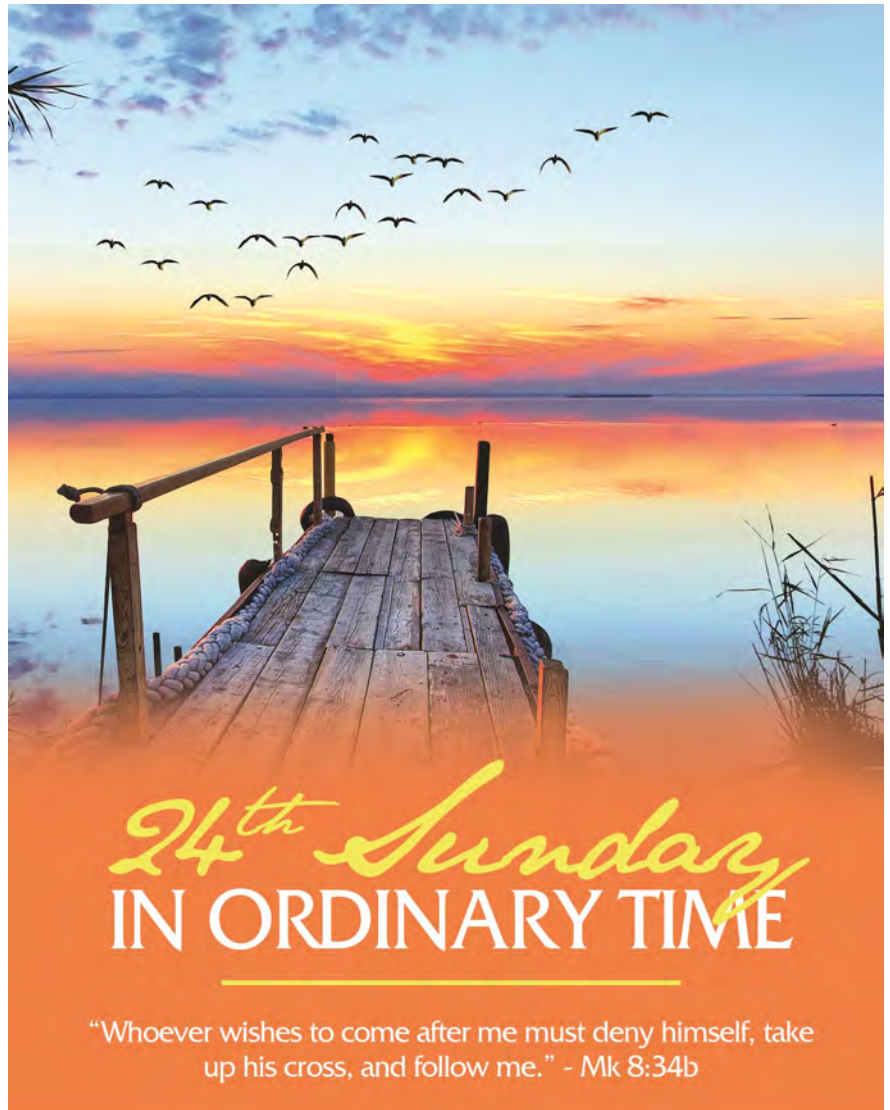

Kid's Corner - Sharing the Gospel

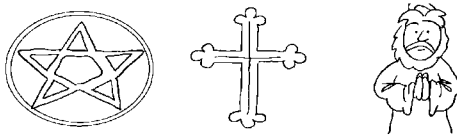

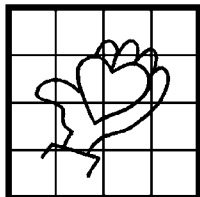

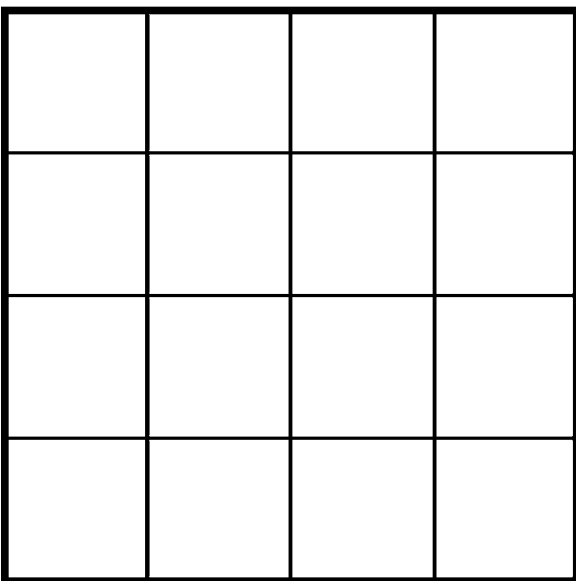
