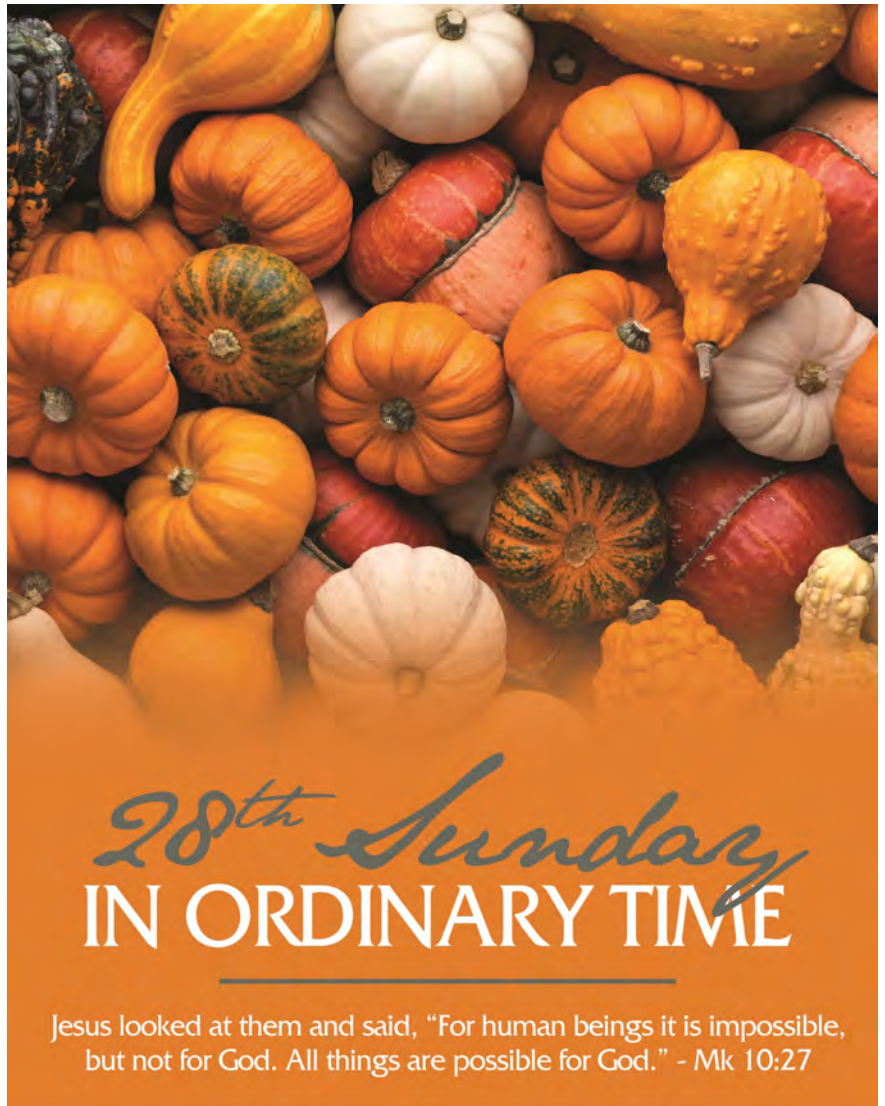

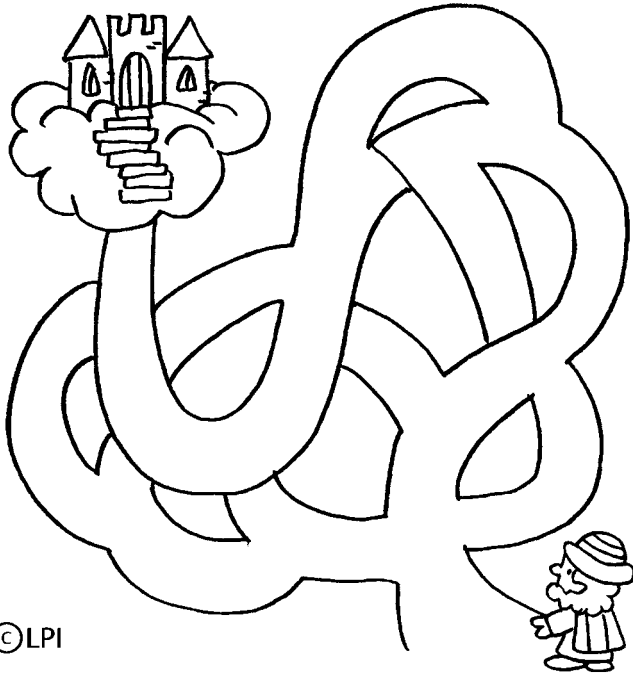

Sharing the Gospel

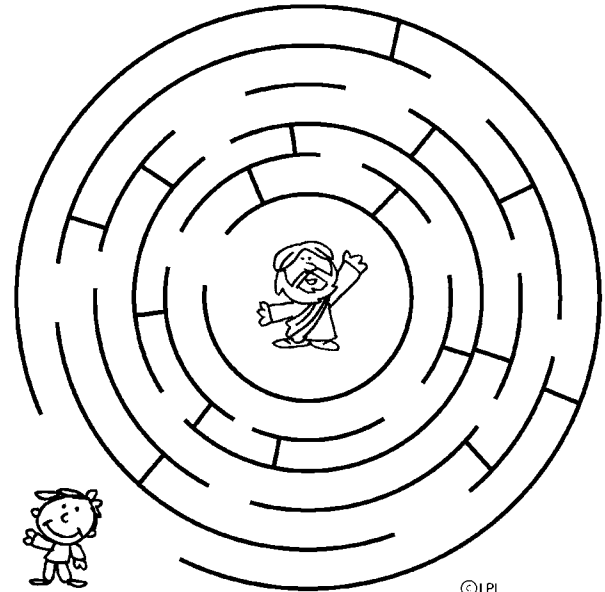

"International Night"

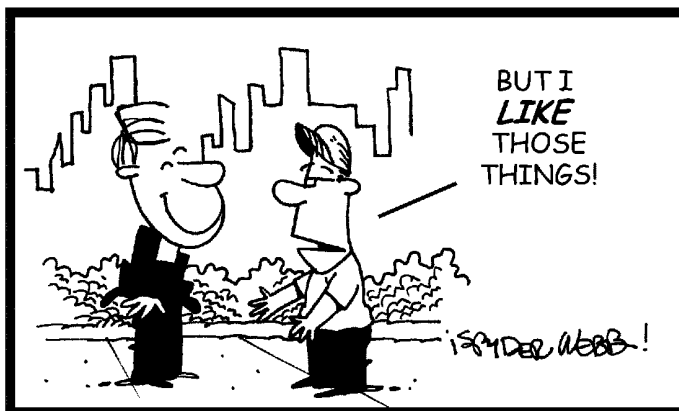

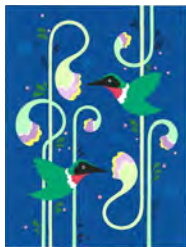


We will be hosting a special recognition over the weekend of November 10th and 11th in conjunction with international night dinner and Veterans Day .
