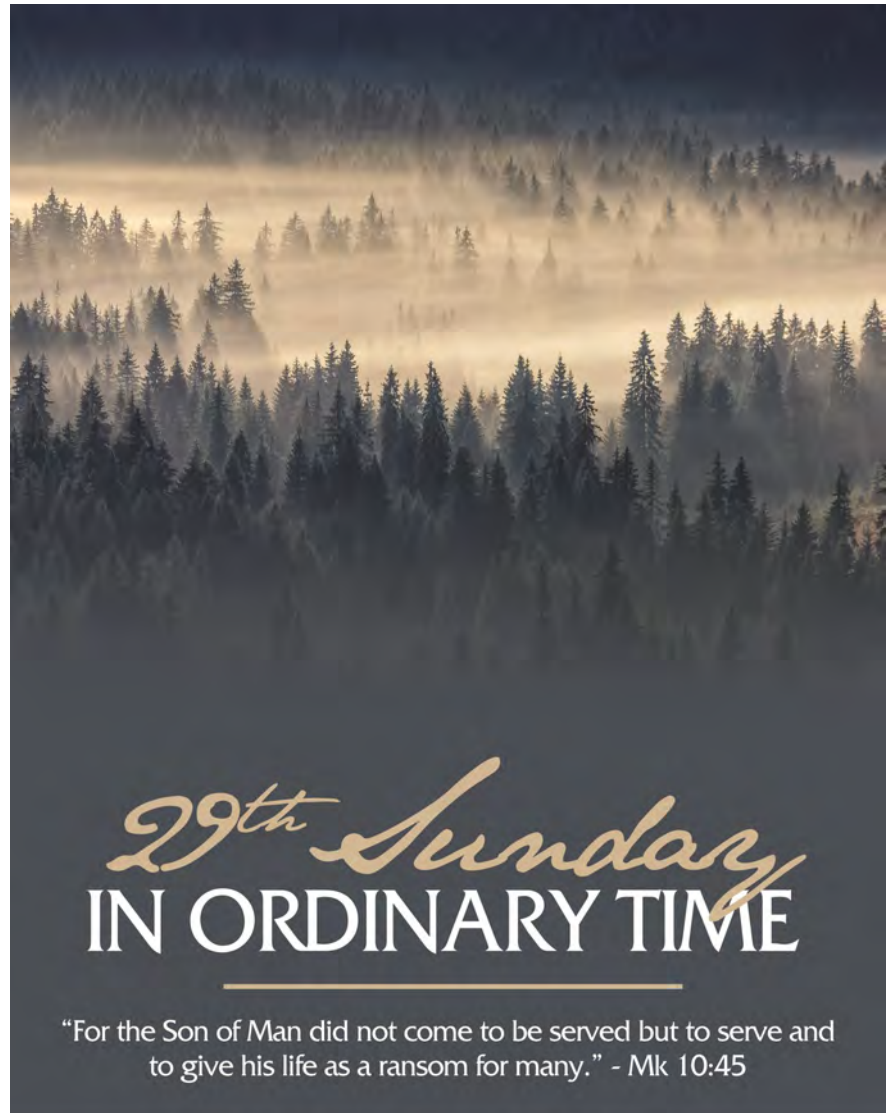

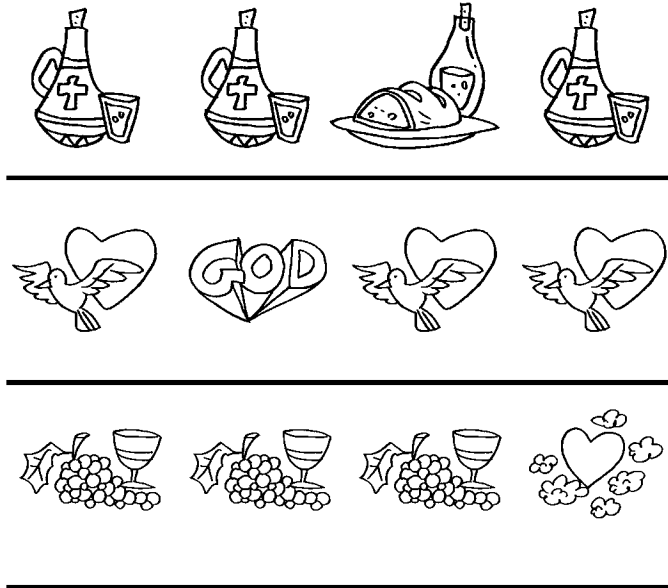

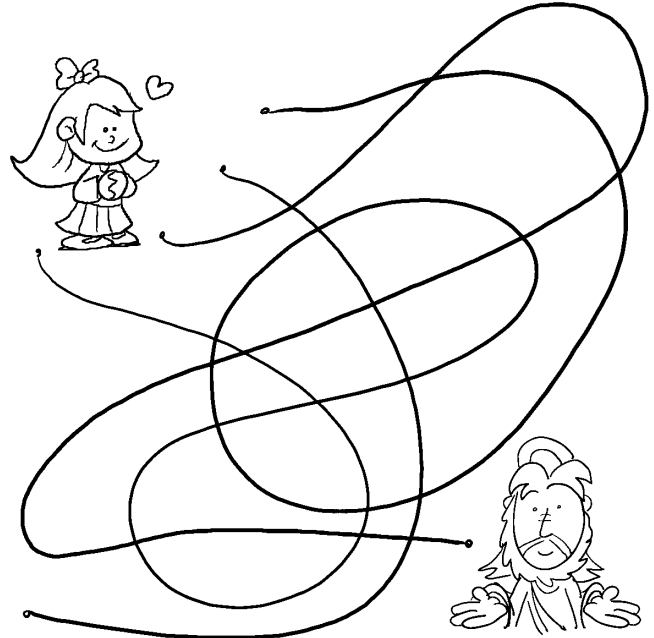
Sharing the Gospel

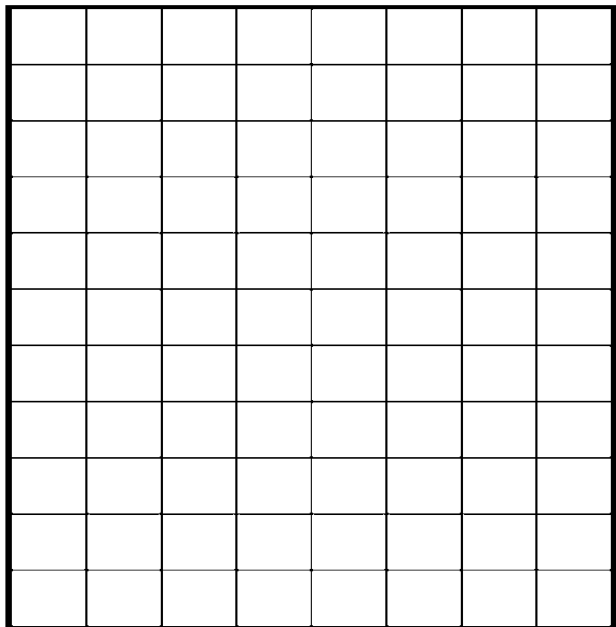
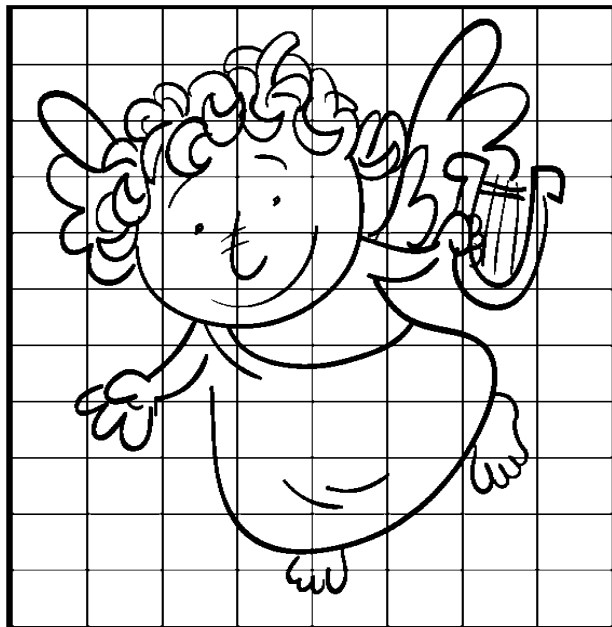

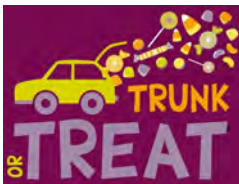
