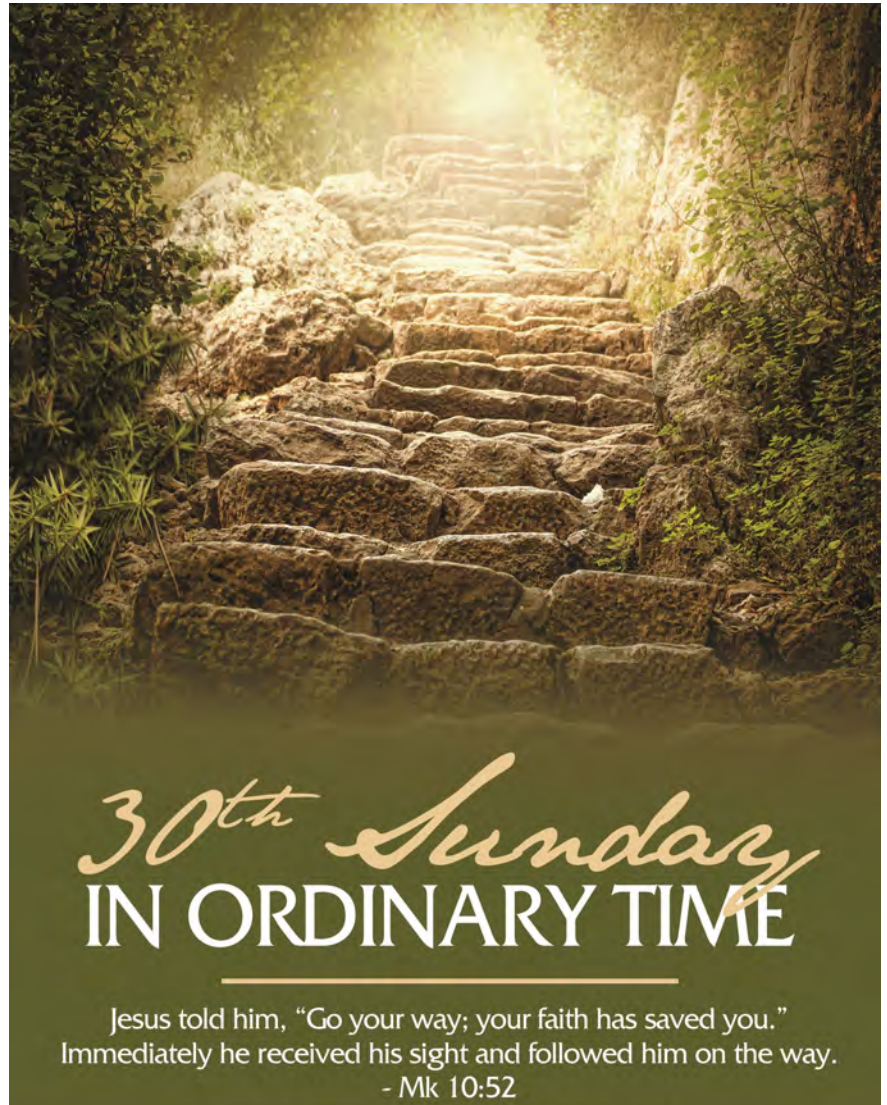

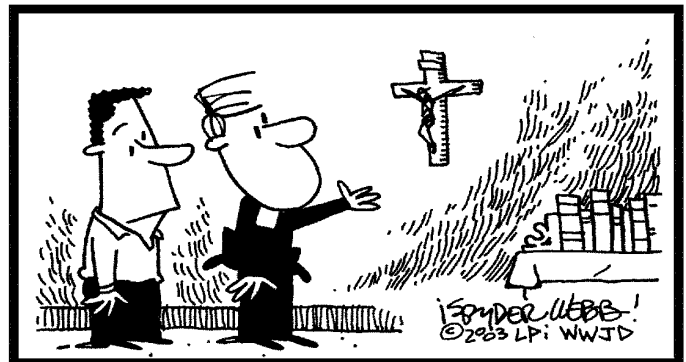
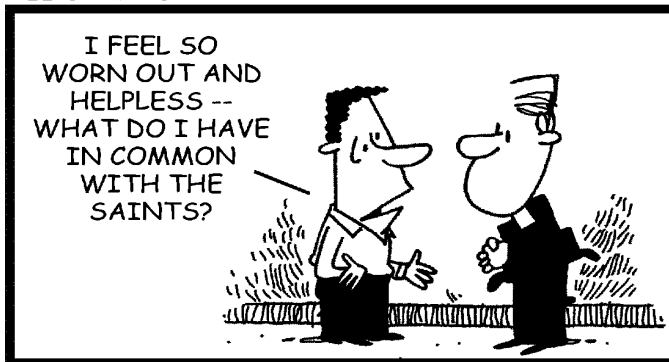

Querida familia parroquial,

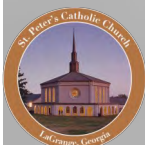
