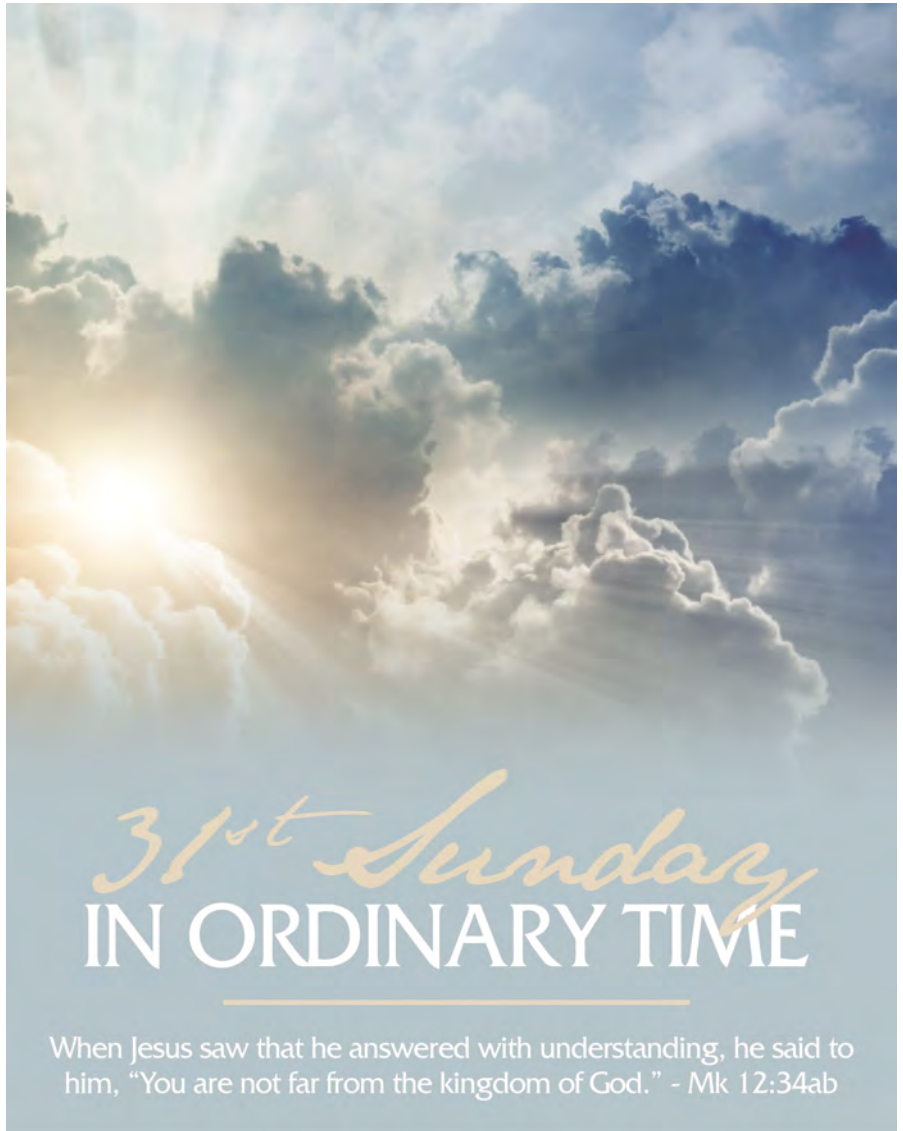

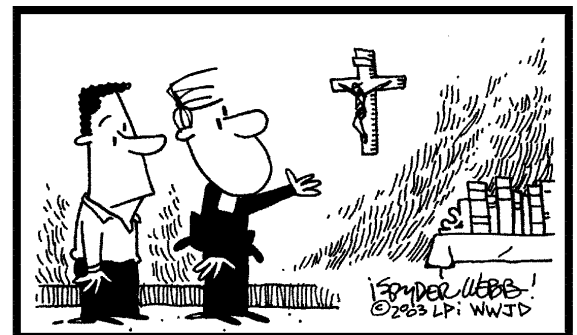
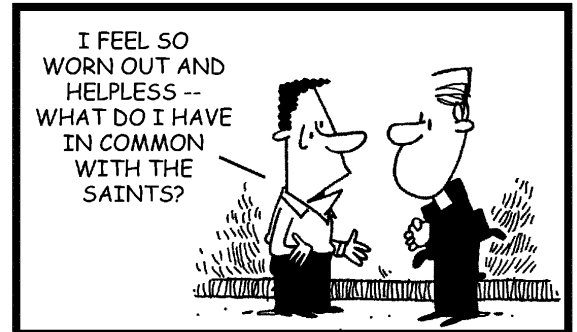
Help Needed

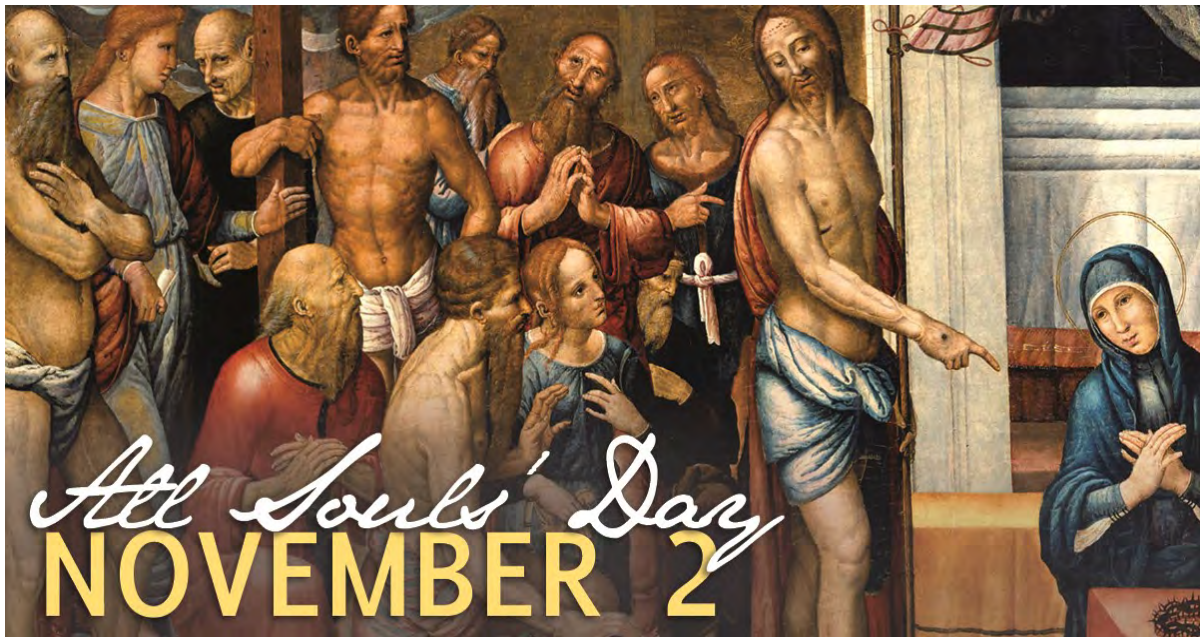
