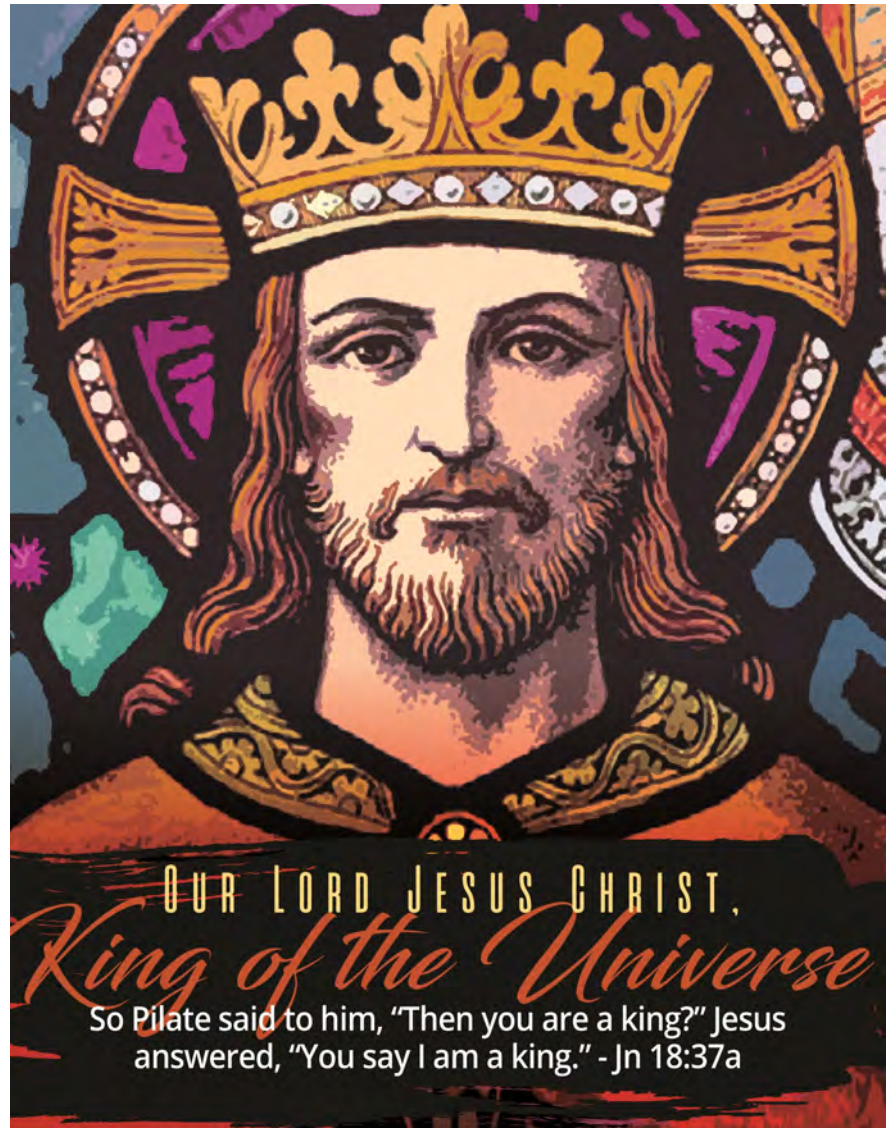

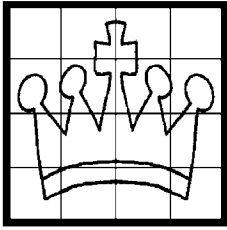
We raised almost \$2,000 last year, let's make that again this year!!

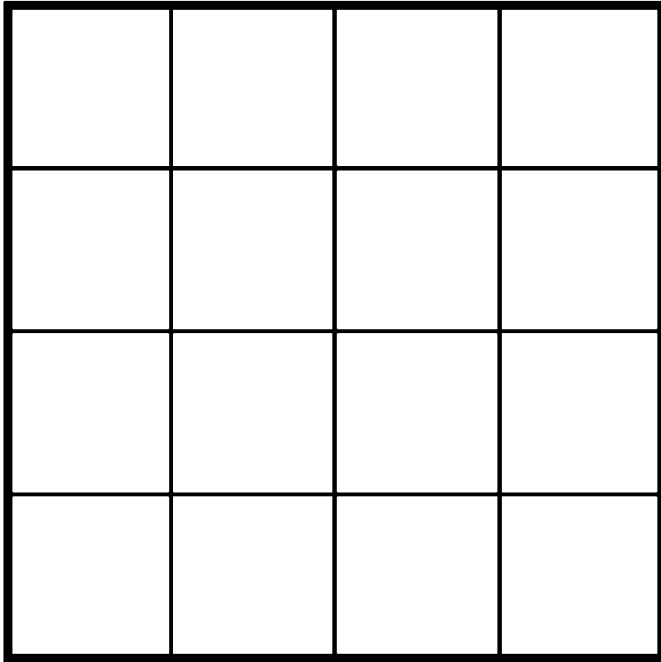


Kids corner

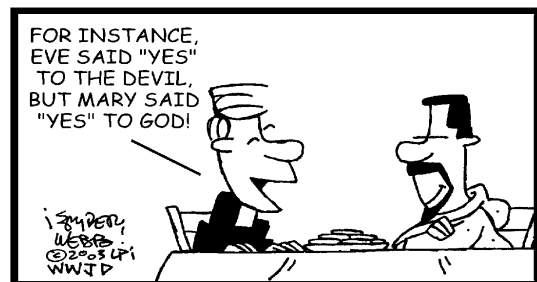
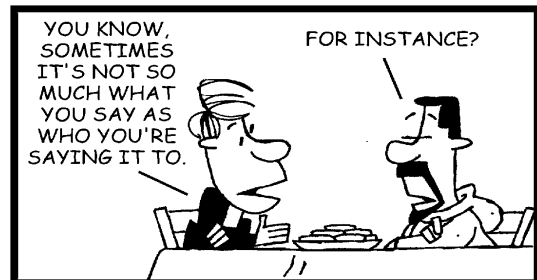
