Our Lady of Guadalupe Festival

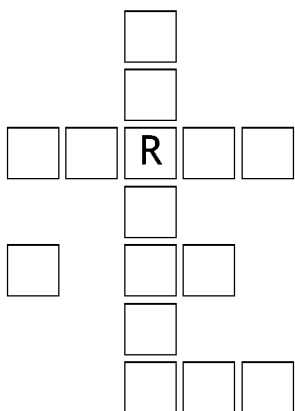

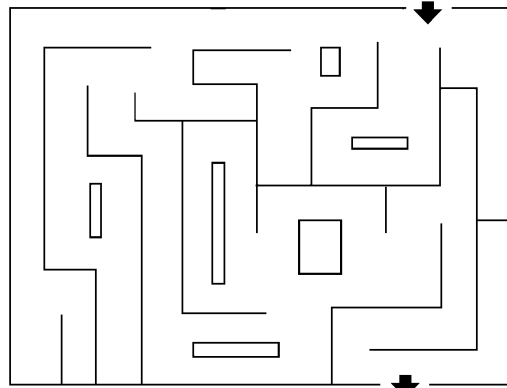
Kids Corner: Sharing the Gospel

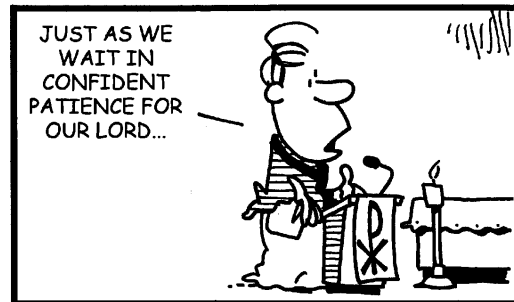
